

SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

Datosill recognises and accepts its legal responsibilities in meeting duties imposed on it by legislation and industry best practice.

Datosill recognises the need to avoid personal injury and ill health of its employees and to others and to see that everything reasonably practicable is done to prevent such.

Datosill considers the maintenance of a safe and healthy working environment to be one of its prime objectives, taking precedence over all other issues if conditions demand it.

The Managing Director will determine Datosill's Health and Safety at work and will be accountable for the implementation of this policy.
The Managing Director will review this policy annually.

Datosill will ensure, so far as is reasonably practicable, the health safety and welfare at work of all employees by providing and maintaining plant and equipment, places of work, arrangements and systems of works and a working environment which are safe and without risks to health.

Datosill will assess risks associated with work activities and other relevant matters and incorporate the results into written training materials and safe working procedures.

Datosill will provide adequate information, training, and supervision as is necessary to ensure, so far as is reasonably practicable, the health and safety of all employees at work.

Datosill will provide a readily available Safety Manual that sets out the detailed health and safety arrangements and control measures etc. outlined in this policy.

Datosill will make readily available all necessary safety devices and protective equipment and to provide supervision in their use.

Datosill will ensure that all accidents resulting in personnel injury and other dangerous occurrences are properly investigated with a view to preventing reoccurrence.
